Contacts:

- For most questions (essay advice, reading recommendations, etc) your first port of call should be your **seminar tutor**. He or she will have office hours during which you can call by with your enquiry.
- For questions about the content of a lecture, you can contact the **lecturer** directly: his or her name will be on the lecture list, and you can look up the email address on the university's address service. However, bear in mind that you should check the Moodle site for that lecture first: the answer may be in the powerpoints / handouts / other materials provided there.
